<p>Schools Closed</p> <p><b>Code 4</b></p> <p><i>Distance Learning Day</i></p>	<p><b>*School Buildings Closed - Distance Learning Day for Students from 10:00am – 3:00pm*</b></p> <p><b>Students will participate in an instructional day, despite the weather, so students do not lose momentum with their learning.
